RIVERcamp – Sports Team

RESPONSIBLE TO: Sports Team Leader

AIMS: To provide a sports programme within the main event programme each afternoon, catering for all age groups.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To coordinate and referee organised sports and games, under the supervision of the sports' team leader.
- Arrive in the sports area at 2pm for a daily team briefing, set up and safety check the sports areas and equipment.
- Staff the sports and games areas as specified by the team leader 2.30pm-4.45pm on Days 2-6
- Be able to give gentle coaching and encouragement.
- Be able to control a game with all players whether, children, teenagers or adults.
- Experience in first aid and refereeing is preferable but not essential.
- Report all disclosures of past and present abuse to your Team Leader. Do not promise confidentiality.
- To liaise with First Aid, Detached and Steward teams when and where necessary.
- As a member of the Sports Team you will **arrive in time for a team meeting at 1:00pm on the day the event starts (Day 1)**, an evening meal will be provided at 5.30pm.
- Work with a team to clear up the sports area at 4pm on the final day

CONCESSIONS:

- Team members receive a half price pass and 2 meals a day.
- Your first meal will be an evening meal on the first day of the event at 5.30pm
- Your last meal will be on the evening of the final day of the event.
- You are responsible for providing your own accommodation.

CONDITIONS

- RIVERcamp has outlined certain Values & Principles for ministry as part of the Child Protection policy, which should be read and understood. While on a team at RIVERcamp, you are expected to accept and work out of these values at all times.
- You should attend all appropriate team meetings during the event.
- You must be 18 years or over.
- There will be a Team meeting on your day of arrival at 7pm, which you **MUST** attend.

APPLICATION NOTES



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Booking in to the event

- Please use the volunteer on-line booking system to book in and pay for any spouse, children or family members you bring and any camping extras such as an electrical hook-up.
- Once we receive your booking you will be contacted and asked to give us details of your DBS check (previously known as CRB) and obtain a reference (normally from your pastor).
- If you are unsuccessful in your application and you still want to attend you may do so by paying the full booking fees to gain a pass to the event. The volunteer Coordinator will discuss this with you. (volunteers@river-camp.co.uk)

Reference

The referee you nominate must not be related to you in any way. If the minister of your church is a relation, please use another leader from your church and specify their job role.

Application procedure

Once we have received your application we will be contacting your Minister or Church leader for a reference. We will also be police-checking all applications. As you can appreciate, these procedures take time, but we will endeavour to keep you posted regarding the status of your application.
