RIVERcamp - SITE TEAM

The Site Support team has a vital role to ensure that the camp runs smoothly from the beginning until the end and covers a range of duties from making sure that equipment is in place at the right time, litter being collected, assisting the onsite electrical team, and even to help the Lenchwood team cleaning toilets and showers if needed.

We work a 16-hour day split into two 8 hour shifts, each shift to have an hour break with free tea/coffee. We are using a shift system to make sure that you have an opportunity to make most of the meetings, but you might not get to all as a good time to do cleaning or maintenance is when everyone is attending one of the events.

As a member of the Maintenance team you will **arrive at least by midday the Tuesday before the start of the camp so you can be briefed and put into a team. A briefing will be carried out at 7pm that evening.**

Your role finishes at 8pm on the Bank Holiday Monday. If you able to stay until the end of Tuesday to further assist in the take down, that would be much appreciated. There will be no additional charge for your camping if you work the Tuesday, (or until released by the team leader when work is complete).

As site crew, you will receive a free pass to the event and are provided with 2 meals a day. You must be prepared to work on a shift system of 8 hours with a break.

You are responsible for providing your own accommodation.

The Lenchwood Team are responsible for removing all rubbish from the service points and keeping the toilets and showers clean, but the RC site team assist if there is a major issue due to extenuating circumstances or an emergency.

RESPONSIBLE TO: The RIVERcamp Site Manager.

AIMS: The main aim of the role is to ensure that the site facilities run smoothly.

DUTIES

- To ensure that the site is set up for the events and meets the requirements of the Health and Safety Executive and Fire Officer
- To ensure that power is made available to all delegates who purchase an electrical hook-up
- To ensure power and water is available at the required times.
- To assist as required in the event of an accident or emergency
- To back-up the Lenchwood Team

CONCESSIONS

- Site Crew receive a free pass to the event and are provided with 2 meals a day.
- You must be prepared to work on a shift basis of 8 hours, with a break.
- You are responsible for providing your own accommodation.

CONDITIONS

- RIVERcamp has outlined certain Values & Principles for ministry as part of the Child Protection policy, which should be read and understood. While on a team at RIVERcamp, you are expected to accept and work out of these values at all times.
- You should attend all appropriate team meetings during the event.
- You must be 21 years or over.
- There will be a Team meeting on your day of arrival at 7pm, which you **MUST** attend.

APPLICATION NOTES

Booking in to the event

- Please use the volunteer on-line booking system to book in and pay for any spouse, children or family members you bring and any camping extras such as an electrical hook-up.
- Once we receive your booking you will be contacted and asked to give us details of your DBS check (previously known as CRB) and obtain a reference (normally from your pastor).
- If you are unsuccessful in your application and you still want to attend you may do so by paying the full booking fees to gain a pass to the event. The volunteer Coordinator will discuss this with you. (volunteers@river-camp.co.uk)

Reference

The referee you nominate must not be related to you in any way. If the minister of your church is a relation, please use another leader from your church and specify their job role.

Application procedure

Once we have received your application we will be contacting your Minister or Church leader for a reference. We will also be police-checking all applications. As you can appreciate, these procedures take time, but we will endeavour to keep you posted regarding the status of your application.
